PREFACE

Dear friends of the İsmail Beşikci Foundation,

We are pleased to share with you our annual activity report of 2021. The ongoing pandemic has continued to affect our activities in part. However, last year we have done a great deal of the activities pointed out in the annual report of 2019 and 2020. We managed to implemented the Spring and Fall Academy programs that we had designed as a part of Kurdish studies and which we had attached great importance to. The Fall Academy of this year has been carried out in Kırmancki (Zazaki) Kurdish. Exultingly, the level of participation in the program was at a level that encouraged us to continue the work to be done in Kirmancki in the coming years.

In 2020, we started monitoring and reporting rights violations against Kurds. Last year, we published our report titled "Rights Violations in the Field of Kurdish Studies in Turkish Universities". This year, we examined the rights violations experienced by artists who make Kurdish music and theater. We have prepared a rights monitoring report based on data obtained from interviews with thirty theater artists and musicians through in-depth interviews. The report analyzed not only current rights violations, but also the challenging tradition that Kurdish artists has relied on, and the exclusionary and disregarding practices of Turkey's dominant cultural and artistic circles towards Kurdish culture. As IBV, we share these reports with the relevant persons and institutions, especially EU parliamentarians, which we have

prepared by addressing rights violations.

In addition to the rights monitoring report, we met with performers and musicians to get to know more about the increasingly serious problems of Kurdish artists due to the pandemic process and held two separate workshops online and face-to-face. In these workshops, we listened to the opinions of the artists about the causes of their problems and their solution suggestions on the methods and institutional practices to overcome the problems. We would like to state that our foundation which supports the works that open up space for the production of information about Kurds, cares about the problems in the field of culture and art. We will keep our eyes open to this area in the future as much as we can.

Our study titled "Main Sources of Kurdish History: Noted Bibliography Study" which started in 2020 and continued this year has been a prominent one. We believe that this study, which excites us all, will be an important reference guide for academicians and researchers especially working in Kurdish History and similar fields. We believe that this work, which will be supported by websites and books, will be a stepping stone to larger studies. We will share the results of this study with you in coming years.

As IBV, we have a vision that does not consider civil society studies as a professional activity isolated from society. We attach great importance to having a relationship with the segments that enter our fields of activity that will make them the subjects of our work. We design Spring and Fall Academies together with academicians and students before the programs. We take into account written and verbal feedback and act accordingly in the next planning. We dream of these studies being collected under an institute in the future. We bring together the experiences and works of our artists, academicians and

thinkers with our online and face-to-face activities such as panel and symposiums. We create ways of collective thinking and production via workshops. Through our website and publications, we strive to contribute to the socialization of information by sharing with the public our activities and the works that arise as a result of our activities.

This year, we held a closed workshop titled "Social Psychology Studies: Research on the Social Psychological Processes Affecting Kurdish Academy Students" at our Diyarbakır representative office. With this study, we aimed to identify the difficulties encountered while conducting academic studies and to offer solutions to overcome them. We see benefits in continuing such studies in Kurdish-Turkish.

We aim to make IBV an institution where information is collectively produced and shared publicly through our vision and activities carried out within this framework. The vision in question received great gratitude from you. A growing number of artists, academics, thinkers and students are becoming part of our work and both our publications and programs are being followed by an increasing number of people. Numerous meetings held with other civil society actors since the foundation has been founded have turned into concrete collaborations in the last 4-5 years. After the pandemic is over, we intend to develop this network of solidarity through joint conferences and workshops, especially summer schools. Thus, – despite the strong beliefs to the contrary – we hope to make a significant contribution to the tradition of doing business together in our society.



1. THE İBV PUBLICATIONS

1.1. Kürt Tarihi Magazine

Kürt Tarihi (Kurdish History) is a popular history magazine published to reproduce, deepen and disseminate knowledge on Kurds and Kurdistan.

Kürt Tarihi has been published since 2012 by a group of researchers, writers and academics who have contributed to the field of Kurdish studies.

The magazine, which started to be published in 2012 bimonthly by a special initiative, has been published by our foundation since 2017, protecting the existing editorial board and publishing team from issue 28. The 43rd, 44th, 45th, and 46th issues of the Kürt Tarihi magazine published quarterly in 2021. Its issues have been published in both print and e-magazine.



Erdnîgariya Kurdistanê II: Wan – Abdurrahman Önen

Erdnîhgariya Wanê (The Geography of Van)

With a population of 1,200,000, Van has a surface area of 20,921 km2 and is larger than many states; For example, Israel has 20,770 km2 and Lebanon's is 10,452 km2 surface area.

Van has 13 districts and 1129 village and smaller settlements. In this book prepared by Aburrahman Önen, the Kurdish and Turkish name of districts, villages and hamlets of Van as well as mountains, rivers, highlands, plains, etc. are presented. In addition to population changes over the years, the book also contains physical maps of the geography of Van.

(The İsmail Besikci Academy Fall 2019 I)

The book entitled "Akademiya Îsmaîl Beşîkcî 209 Payîz I" (The İsmail Besikci Academy Fall 2019 I) is an output of The İsmail Besikci Academy held in Fall 2019.

The İsmail Besikci Academy Fall 2019 I was held in Kurdish in 8 weeks; 32 undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students participated regularly in the academy, where 8 academicians taught. In the program courses on Kurdish Studies under the following topics were given: "Standardization and The Nation", "Faith and Women Poets", "French Archives and Kurds", "Poetry and Nation", "Education and Identity", "The Role of Criticism", "Kurdish Nationalization", "Cinema and Identity". At the end of the program, the articles of five academicians were compiled in this book.

İsmail Beşikci's memoirs were published as a book by İsmail Beşikci Foundation under the title "Söz Konusu Vatansa Bilim Teferruattır! Anılar (Science is Detail When It Comes to Homeland! The Memoirs)" The book of Memoirs is available at İsmail Beşikci Foundation, selected bookstores and internet bookstores.

İsmail Beşikci's Memoirs consists of catchy notes of an unapologetic journey from the late 1960s to the present day that reveal the fact-blindness of academia and thought life in Turkey in every medium without asking for mercy and seeking victimhood, despite the vicious attacks of the able and privileged camp. This is the interlinear of life of a thinker who parted ways with the academy early because he insisted that sensitivity to facts should be shown in a timely manner contrary to the academicism that advises him not to say and write anything at anytime and anywhere: This is a modest narrative of more than 17 years of detention, from research, books and university to prison, from one prison to another, with trials and judging defenses in all kinds of courtrooms...



"Me Di Dil Da Heye Narek Ku Disojit Seqerê" Monitoring Work on Rights Violations Against Kurdish Artists Specific to Musicians and Stage Actors

The report "Monitoring Work on Rights Violations Against Kurdish Artists Specific to Musicians and Stage Actors" has been published as hard copy with the support of Etkiniz.

This study aims to demonstrate the rights violations faced by Kurdish musicians and stage artists who perform their arts mainly in Kurdish with legal, political and cultural dimensions and to contribute to the development of a civil and democratic cultural policy in which they can perform their art freely by raising awareness about the violations.



2.2. Zazaki Academy

An important subject of Kurdish Language and Culture studies, presence of which in the academic field in Turkey can only be seen since 2009, is the Kirmancs (Zazas) and Kirmancki (Zazaki). Studies on the history, language and culture of the Kirmanc (Zaza) Kurds, who live only in the territory under Turkish rule, have been flourishing in recent years both in the world and in Turkey. The lack of academic activities in which the knowledge produced on Kirmancs and Kirmancki is examined and evaluated is due to this delay. The IBV Kirmancki (Zazaki) academy was planned to somehow eliminate the shortfall; to give visibility to the information produced and recorded in the field; to examine the field by specialists; to bring together academicians and researchers working in this field and graduates/students of undergraduate, graduate and doctoral programs interested in this field.

The first of the IBV Kirmancki (Zazaki) Academy, which we had decided to carry out twice a year from 2021 onward, took place online between September 4 and October 2, 2021, at 14:00 – 17:00 every Saturday for five weeks under the title "Kirmancs (Zazas) in the Context of History, Culture and Identity".

83 people applied to Kirmancki (Zazaca) Academy and 37 people were accepted. 22 Men, 13 women and 1 Other/genderqueer were attended. 20 attendees who regularly followed the academy program were given certificates of participation.

2.3. Research On Social Psychological Processes Affecting Kurdish Academy Students

There are many Kurdish students and students doing Kurdish studies in the academic field. These students may face various difficulties or problems during their master's and doctoral studies. In these cases, it directly affects the academic study processes and success levels of the individuals concerned. Therefore, it is a necessity to continue the studies that will contribute to the detection and resolution of such situations.

In this context, the İsmail Beşikci Foundation has prepared a preliminary study program with the participation of academy students to analyze the problems and background in the context of identity-psychology experienced by Kurdish academicians and academicians doing Kurdish studies and to support them with scientific studies. Within the scope of this program, it is aimed to provide the necessary data by studies on various topics and to provide the preliminary requirements of the scientific studies to be continued. The language of the program is Turkish and it is planned to continue the studies in Kurdish in the future process.

Academy students to be participated in the program took part as active stakeholders in the process. Their views were significantly involved in making determinations, discussing the underlying causes and reporting the process. In the studies to be carried out, a wide variety of theoretical information was shared to enrich the discussions and increase the meaningfulness of the results achieved.

A preliminary study program was prepared to analyze the problems and background in the context of

identity-psychology experienced by Kurdish academics and academicians doing Kurdish studies and to support them with scientific studies. 16 people applied to the Research on Social Psychological Processes affecting Kurdish Academy Students, which was conducted face-to-face under the coordination of Eser Karayel inour Diyarbakir representation, and 12 of them were accepted. This program is planned to be held in Kurdish and Turkish in 2022.

4. RIGHTS VIOLATIONS MONITORING ACTIVITY

The efforts to monitor and report rights violations, which we started in 2020, continued in 2021. The Report on Academic Rights Violations in the Field of Kurdish Studies at Turkish Universities was published in 2020.

In 2021, we examined the rights violations of artists who make Kurdish music and theatre with findings from in-depth interviews with 15 musicians and 15 theater-makers who perform their art in Kurdish. As a result of the study, it was found that the artists were subjected to rights violations arising from the state's failure to fulfill its obligations to support the arts and the artist, and rights violations arising from the arbitrary implementation of the law.

"Me Di Dil Da Heye Narek Ku Disojit Seqerê" Monitoring Work on Rights Violations Against Kurdish Artists Specific to Musicians and Stage Actors prepared by our foundation has been published in Turkish, Kurdish and English. You may reach full text of the report via links below:

8. WORKSHOP AND ATELIERS

8.1. Main Sources Of Kurdish History

Analytical and Noted Bibliography Study

We started the preparations in 2020 to compile all the resources created from the first ages of Kurdish history to the present day and to present them to the researchers in order to have the opportunity to write a holistic Kurdish history, the work has continued with a face-to-face workshop in 2021.

For the activity titled "Sources of Kurdish History - Analytical and Noted Bibliography", the main periods of Kurdish history and the language of the sources were determined and divided into sub-periods. A "Writing Rules of the Project" has been prepared and shared for expert researchers on the writing of studies. Studies on periods, resources and assignments have been put in writing.

A two-day workshop was held in Istanbul on October 29-30, 2021 within the scope of the project.

8.2. Workshop and Meetings with S-Woman

Project partnership between our foundation and Socialdemocratic women of Västerbotten (S-Woman) was launched in 2020, within the scope of Olof Palme Center International Project. A series of online meetings were held to develop cooperation and determine the work in the coming period. Moreover, within the scope of the project, a workshop was held face-to-face in Istanbul on November 18-19, 2021. Thirteen people, including 10 women and 3 men, participated in the workshop. Decisions were taken to implement a number of activities and maintain the partnership, including the creation of a gender policy document, and two workshops, one in Diyarbakir and the other in Istanbul, on women's leadership and strengthening participation in NGOs.





8.3. Workshop On Music And Theatre

Kurdish Musicians and Theatre Makers Are Speaking

Two workshops titled "Kurdish Musicians and Theatre Makers Are Speaking" were held in 2021. The theatre workshop was coordinated by director and theatre player Berfin Zenderlioglu and music workshop was coordinated by Zeyneb Yas were the theatre workshop coordinators.

Each workshop was held in 2 days in Istanbul and Diyarbakir. Participants shared the problems and experiences in the fields of music and theater and offered solutions to these problems. At the end of the workshop, 2 separate reports were written focusing on the rights violations, problems faced by theater makers and musicians and solutions.
